<b>Origin</b>	<p>All our lumber is reclaimed from Eastern United States old barns, homes &amp; factories that are generally 100+ years old.</p>		
<b>Disclaimer</b>	<p>Each reclaimed wood board is one-of-a-kind and can possess some or all of the aged characteristics. Variation is to be expected.</p>		
<b>Limitations</b>	<p>While reclaimed wood generally has denser grain structure when compared to new wood products, it does contain checks, marks, knotholes, nail holes and color variations, as well as slight variations in thickness typical of antique lumber. Please allow for these natural variations when designing the application.</p>
